Dear parents,

How we will be giving your child feedback on their learning

Ensuring your child is aware of how well they are doing with their learning is vitally important. In years 1 - 6 the children would usually be given feedback on their learning by their teacher during the lesson or in their book after the lesson. This is the same across the school so that the children are able to see how well they are doing. With our current move to live teaching and remote education we needed to find a way to give the children feedback in a simple way that they understand. Google Classroom allows us to assign a grade to each assignment and lesson the children complete and we have decided to use a 1-3 scale.

If your child is given:

- 1 - they have participated in the lesson but not achieved what we would have expected
- 2 - they have achieved the objective of the lesson and the expectation we set for the class
- 3 - they have exceeded the objective for the lesson and our expectations for the class

The hope is this will keep feedback simple for the children and enable us to use the feedback to address any gaps that appear in learning, just as we would in the classroom. Your child's teacher will be using everything they have seen from your child in the lesson if they have joined the live lesson, as well as any work submitted, to make the judgement on how well your child has done.

This is the minimum your child should expect to receive. They may also get a comment from their teacher suggesting ways that they can improve their work or telling them how well they have done.

Hopefully this will allow the children to see how well they are getting on despite working remotely.
