Hinduism – a major religious and cultural tradition of South Asia, which developed from Vedic religion.

Buddhism – a widespread Asian religion or philosophy, founded by Siddhartha Gautama in north-eastern India in the 5th century BC.

Shinto – a Japanese religion dating from the early 8th century and incorporating the worship of ancestors and nature spirits and a belief in sacred power.

Sikhism – a monotheistic religion founded in Punjab in the 15th century by Guru Nanak.

Judaism - the monotheistic religion of the Jewish people.
