For those at home there are some important rules that must be followed for any 'live' teaching sessions:

-Children must be in a shared family space ideally not their bedroom but we understand everyone has different circumstances which you have to make work for your family , whilst the session is taking place.

-Children must be in earshot of a parent

-Parents/Carers should be mindful that 'background noise' including their own conversation, is picked up on the children's microphone for everyone to hear.

-Children should follow the same behaviour expectations as are in place in school lessons.

-Children must ensure they are dressed appropriately- No pyjamas please.

-Children must arrive at the session on time and remain on mute unless asked to share/speak.

-Teachers have the function to end the call for children not displaying appropriate behaviour and will follow up with a message to parents explaining why.

-Any safeguarding concerns will be referred to the safeguarding team and will be followed up.

There are steps that school staff have in place to guarantee the safeguarding and wellbeing of your children during the 'live' lessons.

-Teachers have high levels of privacy settings applied to their accounts.

-Only those with a @sevenfieldsprimary.org account can access google classroom.

-Teachers have the control to 'mute' all children and they will be able to unmute themselves.
