Agreement: When people feel or think the same way about something, they agree.

Slavery: where a person is owned by and forced to work for another with no pay or rights.

Covenant - A special relationship based on shared promises.

The Torah - The Jewish holy book.

Commandment - one of the Ten Commandments or laws given to Moses by God.

Mezuzah - a small box that is placed on the right doorpost of Jewish homes. Inside the box is a parchment scroll with verses from the Torah inscribed on it.
