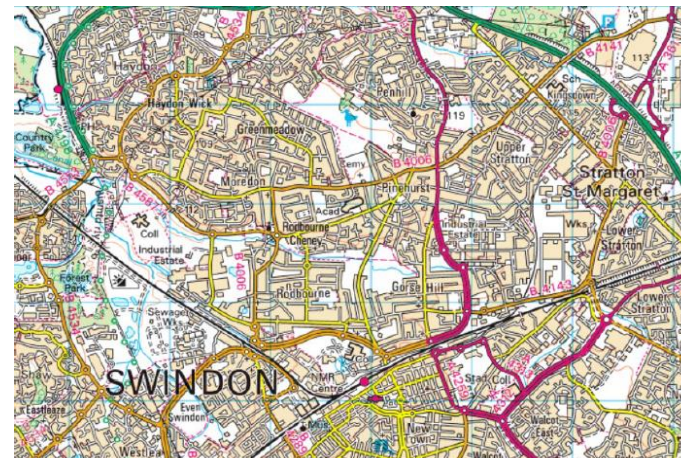

Aerial photograph - a photograph taken from the air

Physical feature - natural features of land e.g. mountains

Human feature - features of land made by humans such as bridges and roads

Settlement - Any place where people live such as a town or village

Scales - the map distance which corresponds to the actual ground distance

Population - all the inhabitants of a particular place

Symbol - A picture that stands for a place on a map
