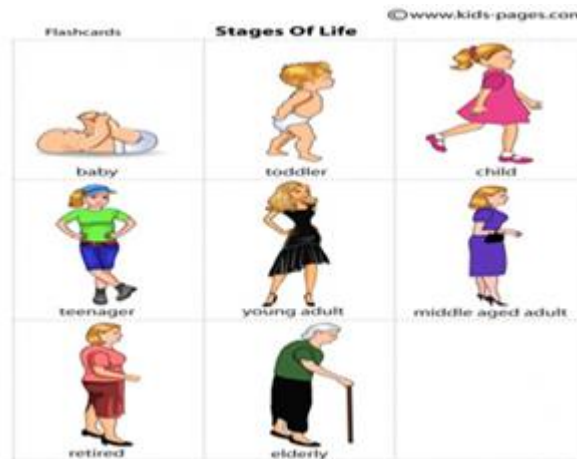
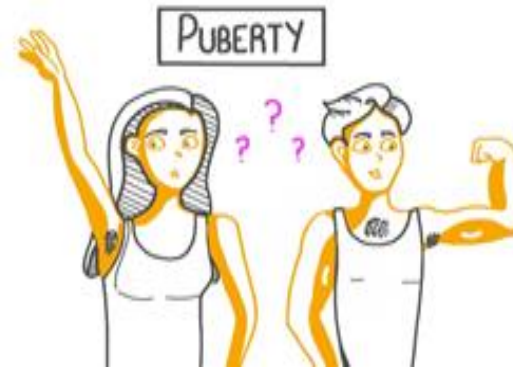

Birth - the arrival of a baby from its mother

Ovaries - A female reproductive organ in which eggs are produced

Penis - A male reproductive organ

Puberty - A time when young adults bodies change and they are capable of reproduction

Sperm - The male reproductive cell that comes from the penis

Uterus/Womb - A muscular organ that helps nourish the fetus prior to birth

Vagina - A female genital organ (internal/inside)

Vulva - A female genital organ (external/outside)

Egg - The female reproductive cells
